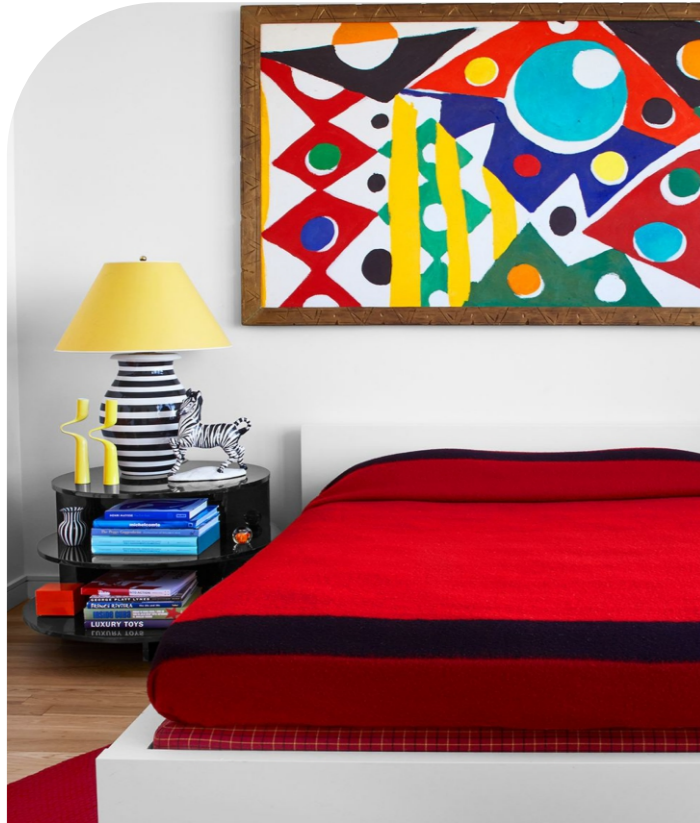

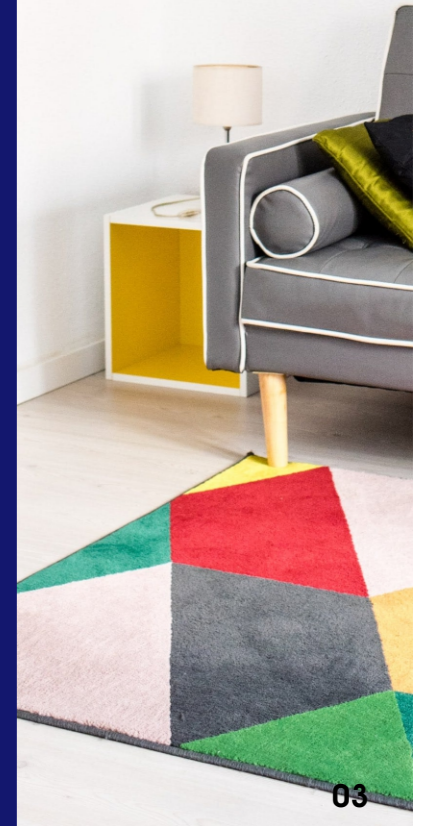

HOW TO CREATE YOUR OWN COLOUR SCHEMES

Creating easy color schemes doesn't have to be complicated. Here's a straightforward guide:

Start with a Base Color:

Begin by selecting a primary color that you love or that suits the purpose of the space. This could be a color from furniture, artwork, or a favorite hue.

Consider the Color Wheel:

Explore the color wheel to find harmonious colors. Analogous colors (next to each other on the wheel) or complementary colors (opposite each other) often work well together.

Choose a Dominant, Secondary, and Accent Color:

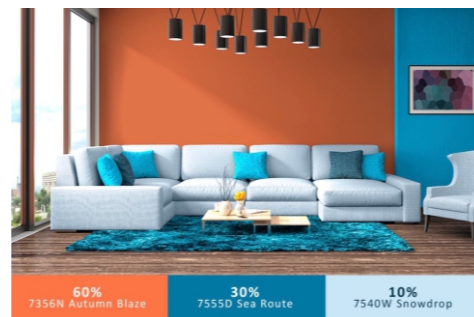
Select one color to be dominant (used the most), another as a secondary color, and a third as an accent color for pops of interest.

Neutral Backgrounds:

Incorporate neutral colors for backgrounds, like walls or large furniture. Neutral tones (whites, grays, or beige) create balance and allow your chosen colors to stand out.

Use the 60-30-10 Rule:

Distribute your colors using the 60-30-10 rule. This means 60% of a dominant color, 30% of a secondary color, and 10% of an accent color.
